

**BYLAW NO. 08-05  
THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STRATHMORE IN THE PROVINCE  
OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC BYLAW #06-18.**

**WHEREAS** the Council deems it necessary to regulate traffic, including off-Highway vehicles and establishing Truck Routes, within the Town;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Traffic Safety Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter T-6* and the *Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26* provide authority for the Town to regulate such matters;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Strathmore, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows.

101. That the Section 2 - DEFINITIONS be amended by adding the following:

g) motor vehicle means

(i) a vehicle propelled by any power other than muscular power,  
or

(ii) a moped,

but does not include a bicycle, a power bicycle, an aircraft, an implement of husbandry or a motor vehicle that runs only on rails.

102. That Section 2 - DEFINITIONS be re-numbered accordingly.

201. That Section 12 - PARKING be amended by adding the following:

"1220. No person shall park a motor vehicle or trailer on Town of Strathmore property to advertise the motor vehicle or trailer for sale.

1221. No person shall park a motor vehicle or trailer on Town of Strathmore property for the purpose of storage of the said motor vehicle or trailer.

1222. No person shall park a motor vehicle or trailer on any highway within the Town of Strathmore with expired, invalid or no license plates.
