4. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

4.1 40 km/hr speed limit

Bryce reviewed reduction of speed limits for centre and Cambridge, got feedback from consultants and engineers. How to measure success because of low accident rates. Consultant advised we perceive a need and is there a negative impact because of it. How does the change affect the roadways around it, does it divert to another roadway. Do a traffic count on

surrounding roads and then run the pilot, then do traffic count on surrounding roads. Check is see what kind of impact does the reduction have. Once we have results then we can survey residents on reduction of speed.

Bryce would come to council for costs of traffic counts and costs of survey to the residents. What type of traffic are we diverting from the collector road to the other roads and what kind of issues does this cause to the other roads. Chris was concerned about diverting traffic to Centennial where there are traffic concerns already.

Proposed timing is traffic count late spring early summer, the pilot to run summer to summer. Do survey near the end of the pilot. Suggested survey could be done before and then one after the pilot. Survey results come back positive and traffic counts show that no extra traffic and make recommendation at that time and then look at other roadways. Traffic counts done in April and then again in April after signs up for a period of time.

Bryce will get ready for April 24 meeting, please provide feedback by April 7, 2017.

4.2 RCMP Stats

Chris reviewed statistics from enhanced program and tickets that are written. Recently added time and location on statistics. Large amount of tickets are non resident tickets. Working on goals for tickets for members. Dramatic increase in collisions when the weather is bad. Collisions are down from last year.

Bob asked about speed signs that are solar powered which administration is pricing out. We are planning on getting a 90 day trial.
