A Person Is
NOT ELIGIBLE

To Be Nominated As A Candidate If, On Nomination Day:

- The person is an auditor of the Town of Strathmore;
- The person is an employee of the Town of Strathmore, unless the person takes a leave of absence without pay.
- The person is indebted to the Town of Strathmore for taxes in default exceeding \$50;
- The person is indebted to the Town of Strathmore for any debt exceeding \$500 for more than 90 days; and
- The person has, within the 10 previous years, been convicted of an offence under the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

If you wish to run as a councillor, you must have been a resident of the local jurisdiction for at least the

In order to be eligible to vote in the Strathmore Municipal Election a person must meet the following requirements:

- Must be 18 Years of age or older.
- Must be a resident of the Town of Strathmore.
- Must be a Canadian Citizen.
- Must have resided in Alberta for the six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding Election Day.
