

Development Permit Definitions

Under Review - Public Comments Accepted

The proposed application has been circulated to adjacent landowners within 50 metres of the subject property. Adjacent landowners can submit written comments to the Planning Department for two (2) weeks.

In Progress - Feedback Reviewed with Applicant

The Town of Strathmore is no longer receiving written comments from adjacent landowners. Feedback received from adjacent landowners is currently being discussed with the applicant and revision to the application are being made.

Approved Awaiting Appeal Period Closure - Public Comments Accepted

The proposed application has been approved and has been circulated to adjacent property owners within 50 metres of the subject property. Adjacent landowners and/or the applicant has two (2) weeks to appeal the proposed Development Permit decision. Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Town of Strathmore within two (2) weeks of the Development Permit decision.

Approved - Development Permit Released

The proposed application did not receive any appeals from adjacent landowners during the two (2) week appeal period. The Development Permit has been officially approved. No further circulation or public comment is necessary.

Application Appealed

The proposed application has received a written appeal within the two (2) week appeal period. The appeal must be heard at a Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) hearing. Scheduled appeal hearings will be posted on the Town of Strathmore webpage.
