Splash Park Water Recycle Program

Colin Huxted gave a verbal overview of the information provided to upgrade the Splash Park to recycle water. The Committee reviewed and discussed the information.

4.2 Plastic Bag Use in Strathmore Retail Outlets

Christine Huxted drafted an information sheet to encourage the reduction of single use plastic bags in the community.
