Description of Program

Town of Strathmore day and weeklong camps provide mental and physical activity at times when school is unavailable (summer break, PD days and holidays). Camps are usually themed for an added element of fun and activities included but not limited to games, special guests, sports, and field trips. The Town of Strathmore will work with community partners to provide interactive outings when available.

Drop Off and Pick Up

Drop off time is between 8:45-9:00am. All participants must be signed in at the time of their drop off. Pick up time is between 4:45-5:00pm. Participants can only be picked up by their legal guardians or a designated pick-up person. Participants will not be released to anyone that has not been given permission to do so on the Camp Registration Form. If late pick-ups become an issue (more than 1 or 2 times) the participant may be asked to leave the program.

Drop off and pick up times are subject to change depending on the program schedule, if this occurs Guardians will be notified ahead of time.

Camp Pre-Care

Drop off time is between 7:45am-8:45am. All participants must be signed in at the time of their drop off. Preregistration is required at a rate of \$4.75 per day or \$16.80 per week.

What to Bring Everyday:

- Healthy lunch and 2-3 snacks depending on your child's dietary requirements (no nut products please)
- Water bottle (water bottle filling stations are available in the facility)
- Clean indoor footwear
- Weather appropriate outerwear, shoes, and hats (Camp participants will be walking to off site locations for activities)
- Light jacket or sweater in case they are cold indoors

- Backpack
- Required prescribed medications (a Medication Dispensing Form must be filled out for each medication)
- Swimwear and towel.

What to Leave at Home:

- Toys and blankets (if your child requires a sensory item please indicated this in the “Behavioral Concerns” section of the Camp Registration Form)
- Games and trading cards
- Electronics (tablets and cell phones and handheld gaming devices)
- Any special items or jewelry that may get lost

On certain days participants may be required to bring additional items. Guardians will be notified when these items are needed ahead of time in the Camp Week Activity Pamphlet.

Day Camp Fees and Cancellation Policy

The fees for each Camp program have been determined based on the cost of services and materials for the duration. The Town of Strathmore aims to provide cost effective programs to residents.

Fees for the entire duration of the Camp are due at the time of registration. Registration slots cannot be reserved or held without full payment.

Payment methods accepted:

- Cash or Debit or cheque in person at the Strathmore Motor Products Sport Centre
- Visa or Mastercard over phone, email or in person

Cancellations made in writing 7 business days prior to the start of camp will be permitted a refund minus the \$20.90 administrative fee. A cancellation request made less than 7 days prior to the start of camp will not receive a refund. Should you require a transfer of camps there will be a \$10.20 transfer fee. Prorated refunds will not be given if a participant misses a day for any reason. Exceptions where a full/partial refund may be given regardless of refund policy include: injury/illness that prevent participation in the program and a date stamped doctors note is provided. Other extenuating circumstances may be considered at the Managers discretion.

Payment Assistance

Families requiring fee assistance can apply for the Community Access discount card with the Strathmore FCSS (located at the Strathmore Municipal Building), 403-934-9090. Families that qualify will receive a discount at the time of registration. Registrations using the Community Access discount must be done in person and identification is required. Please start the application process before registration fees are due to allow time for the application to be processed.
